Freeding - Borrow ebooks to read on your eReader (except Kindle), tablet, or computer without waiting.

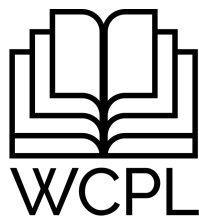


Hoopla - Borrow free comics, digital video, music, and audiobooks with your library card. All titles are downloadable.

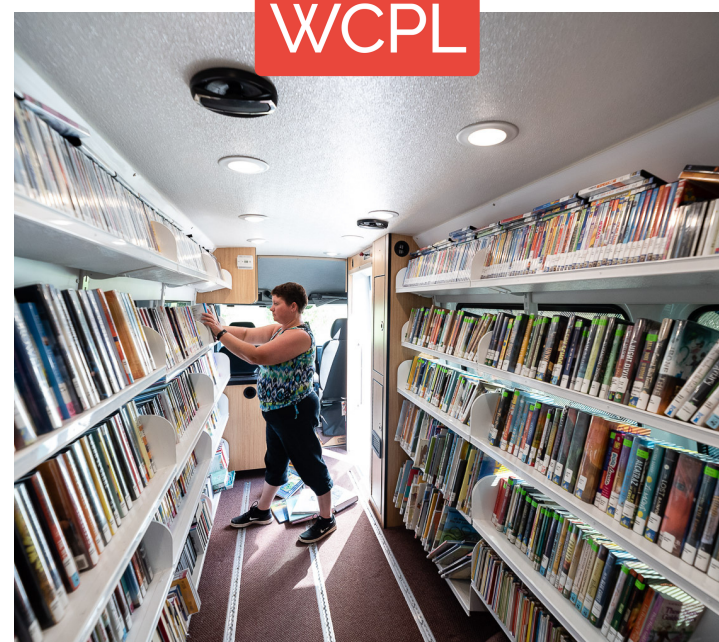
